REGISTRATION FEE: Includes two nights lodging and 4 meals, (no meal provided Friday night or Sunday lunch) does not include transportation to or from camp. Parking is an issue at camp so carpooling is encouraged. Think clean and spiffy, but a youth campground.

Unfortunately, due to covid, camp and county restrictions, Calvary's spaces are very limited. Registration form and payment is needed to reserve your spot. If you are not able to attend, we will assist you in transferring your registration, however, you will be responsible for collecting reimbursement.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Arrival Info: Check-in time is 4 pm or after. Feel free to head up to Williams early, but do not plan on arriving to the campgrounds before 4. Upon arrival, check in at registration. If arriving late (after the 7 pm session begins) please let us know beforehand.

Room and Bathroom: The rooms hold between 6 to 10 women with bunk beds. At <u>this time</u> no upper bunks will be used and masks may be required. (subject to change) Each room has a seperate bathroom with shower and toilet stalls.

Friday Night Dinner: Friday night dinner is <u>not</u> included. There are several restaurants nearby or bring your meal.

Sunday Departure: After the Sunday morning service, you are on your own for lunch. All rooms must be vacated by 11:00 a.m.

Cell Phones: There is cell service at the campground. Some have found it to be spotty, but you can get coverage. Please do be respectful with making and receiving phone calls during session times and in the cabins. All cell phones must be on silent after 10:00pm in the cabins and if you are using your speaker phone please walk away from others.

Packing: Here is a brief list of some things to bring:
