## SERMON NOTES

The Celebration vs 36-40

- Jesus' followers praised Him for who he is and what he's done.
- Is praising Jesus a normal part of life or a special event?

The Sorrow vs 41-44

- Jesus grieved because the people missed him.
- Is your attitude toward the unchurched one of compassion or anger?

The Indignation vs 45-46

- Jesus was angry at those misrepresenting God.
- What tables would Jesus overturn in your life?

## GETTING STARTED

What is one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this grab your attention?

In the message Pastor Chad asked the question; "Is praising Jesus a normal part of your life or a special event?" How would you answer? What works for you in helping you praise God when you're not in church? What "praise habits" have you built into your life?

Pastor Chad pointed out that Jesus was sorrowful because the people of Jerusalem "missed" him. What is your usual attitude toward those who do not confess Christ? Would you identify yourself as compassionate, angry, or indifferent? Why?

Read Psalm 150:6

What does the Bible mean when it says to praise God?

In light of this discussion what ways have you discovered that you now could praise Jesus?

2 Corinthians 5:19-20

In what ways do we, as followers of Christ, misrepresent Jesus?

## TAKING IT HOME

Pastor Chad reminded us this week that Jesus, in indignation, drove out those who sold in the temple. (Luke 19:45-46 "And He entered the temple and began to drive out those who sold, 46 saying to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of robbers.") Pastor Chad asked us "What tables would Jesus overturn in your life?" While we are asking ourselves that important question this week, let's also remember to praise Jesus for not only overturning those "tables" in our lives, but also for all He does for us every day.
